1 The Court has separately entered an order granting final approval of the parties' class
2 action settlement pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23, which has settled the class
3 claims in this action in their entirety. The Court's findings of fact and conclusions of law stated
4 within that order are expressly incorporated herein by reference.

5 As stated in the class action settlement agreement, the Court will have continuing
6 jurisdiction after judgment for the purposes of addressing: (1) the interpretation and enforcement
7 of the terms of the settlement; (ii) settlement administration matters, (iii) such post-judgment
8 matters as may be appropriate under Court rules or as set forth in this settlement Agreement, and
9 (iv) the individual claims of Sharon Davis.

10 Accordingly, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 58, and subject to the Court's
11 continuing jurisdiction as set forth above, the Court directs the Clerk of the Court to enter
12 Judgment. Pursuant to the class action settlement agreement and final approval order, this
13 Judgment shall apply to the entire action, except for the individual claims of Plaintiff Sharon
14 Davis, which the Court previously severed to be addressed after resolution of the class action
15 claims.
